- a. NRCS Torres announced deadlines for applications for NRCS programs. At the end of 2016 there were 16 EQIP applications with 4 funded. There will be a focus CSP projects in 2017. Aalia McClendon announced she is transferring to a new position in Georgia with today being her last day as an employee of this NRCS office.
- b. FDACS Due to Nickerson's absence from the meeting, Bishop reported the Citrus Re-Establishment Contract is far from being allocated and the deadline for application is January 13 so the un-used funds can be re-distributed to other contracts.
- c. MIL Bishop reported the MIL Evaluations are ahead of required amount and have also completed five well calibrations this quarter.

- a. Lake McCoy Project Fentress reported she had inquired with SWFWMD for an update. All contracts are signed and RFPs for bids for the Lake McCoy project and the Lake June project will be combined projects to the winning vendor. Lake June has been a project for 10 years so the actual work for it could take place before Lake McCoy. Once project is awarded to the selected vendor the job has to be completed in 110 days. Fentress sent an update to the property owners with no negative comments received back.

- c. USDA-NRCS Technical Review Committee Bishop reported she attended the meeting in Gainesville last month and was the only SWCD represented. NRCS State Conservation Director applauded HSWCD for being present. The outcome of the Highlands local working group meeting was shared and well received.

She expressed her inquiry with AFCD for the Area 4 Youth Speech Contest to be held at the meeting too, but that isn't confirmed as of today. In an effort to have a County winner in time to compete at the Area 4 meeting, the HSWCD Youth Speech Contest will be held on March 21, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. following the regularly scheduled Board Meeting. Packets will be delivered to the schools following the Christmas break.
- c. Soils Workshop Bishop explained she and Steve Smith met to discuss options for the soils workshop HSWCD will host. The date is February 22, 2017 from 10 12 Noon. Dr. Tyler Jacoby and his staff with Highland Precision Ag. will be providing the instruction. Discussion regarding the goals and objectives of the workshop took A Board workshop to formulate the details of the soils workshop will be held on January 3 at 1:00 p.m. Bishop will invite Highland Precision Ag. representative/s to the planning workshop.
