TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, a certificate of organization of the Istokpoga Soil Conservation District as a governmental subdivision of this State and a public body corporate and politic was issued by this office on the first day of January, 1945; and

WHEREAS, T. U. Jackson, Cole McD. Danley, Jr., J. R. Gilbert, E. W. Hartt, C. P. Anderson, landowners residing within the proposed territory to be included, who signed the petition to the State Soil Conservation Board requesting a public hearing on the question of the inclusion, presented to this office on the first day of January, 1945, an application in the form required by law, for a certificate of organization reflecting inclusion of additional territory described as all lands lying within the boundaries of Highlands County, Florida not originally included within the boundaries of the existing Istokpoga Soil Conservation District; and


WHEREAS, the said application was accompanied by a statement from the State Soil Conservation Board in the form required by law, and
